DARLENE'S PEANUT CLUSTERS

STELLA'S FRIEND DARLENE DAVIS SHARES A HOME RUN HOLIDAY TREAT!

2 to 3 18-ounce jars salted, dry roasted peanuts

2 16-ounce packages white bark candy, broken into chunks

1 16-ounce package milk chocolate bark candy, broken into chunks

1 12-ounce package good quality semisweet chocolate chips

Sheets of parchment or waxed paper

In large (6 to 8 quarts) mixing bowl place two jars of salted peanuts. In large microwave safe container place bark chunks and chocolate chips. Microwave on high for 45 seconds; stir. Keep microwaving 45 seconds at a time and stirring until chocolate is melted and smooth. Do not overheat. Pour over peanuts; mix well. If it looks "runny" mix in the last jar of peanuts. Working quickly drop by heaping teaspoons onto parchment or waxed paper. Allow to firm up at room temperature. Store in containers or freeze for up to 3 months. Makes at least 7 to 8 dozen, depending on size.
