THE WHY OF PERSECUTION BY GARY GILBERTSON

Persecution is one of the "seven P's" we believe God has lead us to emphasize as we work to disciple a generation of students anticipating the return of Jesus. The first murder in the history of the world took place just outside the gate of the garden of Eden. Cain killed Abel. This was the beginning of religious persecution which will continue until the coming of the Lord. Cain believed his good works would qualify him for the favor of God while Abel believed it was the blood of a lamb that would bring forgiveness of sins and the favor of a Holy God. Those who believe in




man's good works to earn salvation will always hate those who believe in God's righteous sacrifice for salvation.

INCREASING PERSECUTION

Currently there are at least 60 countries where you could be imprisoned or killed by the government for trusting in Christ for salvation. Radical Muslims and Hindus are leaders in persecution but atheistic countries like North Korea and China have a long history of beating, imprisoning, and killing believers in Jesus.

A whopping 75 percent of the world lives in an area with severe religious persecution. In our own country, religious liberties are being challenged at an alarming rate. For instance a large Christian company, Hobby Lobby is being threatened with fines exceeding one million dollars a day for refusing to fund abortion-inducing drugs. This is just one of 1200 incidents of hostility to religion in America, double the incidents from 2012.




WHAT DOES THIS MEAN ?!

One of Jesus' promises to us is "If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you." {John 15:20} We'll meet persecution if we're actively serving Christ. I've spent a little time the last few



weeks with a student from Iraq. If she tells people about Christ back home,



she'll be arrested and lose her job. Just before she left to pursue her graduate degree in America, the Islamic government shut down her church. Prepare students at her campus are praying fervently for her.

Even though they don't experience this kind of persecution, they can "participate in their suffering" through constant prayer for brothers and sisters all over the world. "And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it..." {1 Cor 12:26}




NEW BAN ON BIBLES BY WAIHON LIEW

Waihon Liew, new husband of only a few months to Donna (Swanson) Liew, is stuck in Malaysia due to visa complications. He is actively ministering there while awaiting to be reunited with Donna. Waihon writes of the increasing persecution in his homeland:

"Religious tensions are arising from the Christians using the term 'Allah' in their common Bible. Allah is the common word meaning God, but Muslims are claiming it is the name of their God. All Christian Bibles are now banned by the government of Malaysia. This is adding fuel to the

radical element of Islam. They have already burned several churches, some pastors have

been arrested, and many churches have gone underground. Please pray for our brothers and sisters in Malasyia as they face blaspheme charges if caught with a Bible."

November 10 marks the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church. Bill and Darlene Davis visited Prepare campuses




again this Fall. Bill's testimony of transformation from a life of crime and despair continues to impact students. Their daily habit is to pray for the persecuted church.



STELLA'S RECIPE CORNER - CRISPIX SNACK MIX

This has become our family's favorite sweet treat at Christmas. It's also great for giving.

Preheat oven to 350° Coat with cooking spray one 12x18-inch pan OR two 9x13-inch pans; set aside.

Bring the butter, brown sugar and corn syrup to a boil over medium heat: cook five minutes, stirring constantly during cooking. Remove from heat and immediately add baking



In large (10-12 quart) bowl, toss together evenly: 12 ounce box Crispix cereal (10-12 cups) or generic equivalent 1 cup pecan halves 1 cup slivered almonds 1 cup coconut

In heavy-duty pan, melt: 2 sticks butter, 1 cup brown sugar (packed), 1/2 cup light corn syrup

Have ready in small bowl: 1 teaspoon baking soda, dash of salt, and 1/8 teaspoon cream of tartar.

soda, salt, and cream of tartar. Mix in (mixture will foam) and pour over cereal mixture. Using two large spoons, toss to coat evenly. Quickly add Crispix mixture to prepared pan(s). Bake 8 minutes, lift and stir with spatula. Bake 8 minutes longer. Remove from





oven, spread in single layer onto waxed or parchment paper on counter to cool

completely. Break up and store in airtight container or Ziploc bags. Makes about 3 quarts.
